'Abd al-'Azīz Ar-Rājihī¹ on Suicidal Acts of "Martyrdom"²

Question: Many people talk about acts of "martyrdom" that are carried out in Palestine and other places. So what is the ruling of actions like these?

Answer: Regarding such actions, I heard the honorable Shaykh Abd al-'Azīz Ibn Bāz, may Allāh have mercy on him, pass a religious verdict that they are considered nothing but suicide and that it's forbidden for a person to strap explosives to himself and then detonate them because this is suicide combined with murder.³
